This summer we quietly celebrated June 24th, 2023 as the one year anniversary since the ruling Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization was handed down, overturning Roe v. Wade. While the nation celebrated a victory for Life, the state of Michigan was handed a defeat with the passing of Proposal 3, which allowed for unregulated abortions. Despite the passing of this proposal, a poll done by the Michigan Catholic Conference revealed more than 60% of voters support parental consent and the 24-hour waiting period. More than 90% of voters support abortion facilities to be regulated and licensed. Right to Life of Michigan continues to fight at a state level to prevent the repeal of these important laws.

At a local level, our presence at the National Night Out was met with positive comments and support by the community. We are working with one parochial school to educate our future prolife generation on life issues. We will be sending local buses to the State March for Life on November 8th to show our legislators we will not sit idly back while they destroy all the work that has been done over the last fifty years to support life. Please continue to pray for our state and our elected leaders. Pray for open hearts to hear the truth about the horrors of abortion, which is the gate to devaluing life of all stages. Consider what you are being called to action to do, to support life from conception to natural death.


